Recreational Fire Burn Permit

The Property Owner listed on this Permit MUST be present at the site of the fire.

- This Permit is not transferable. This permit may be revoked for any violation of the TTPOA Rules of Conduct, State and Local Burning Violations.
- This Permit is not for the use of backyard debris burning, a separate permit must be applied for to burn backyard debris.
- Before you start the fire, you must check wind direction and do not proceed to burn if wind speeds are over 10 mph.
- Only burn aged dry wood or charcoal.
- The location of the fire should not be within 15 feet of any structure.
- Remember if the remnants of the fire are too hot to touch, it's too hot to leave unattended.
- The total burn area of a recreational fire should be no more than three (3) feet surface area and no more than two (2) feet high.

- Area cleared (no overhanging trees)
- Ground dug and loosened six Inches Deep and six (6) feet in diameter (for Ground Fire Ring)
- Stones surrounding the site
- Water hose within 10 feet of fire and turned on and operable or a Class A rated Fire Extinguisher

The preceding regulations are required to prevent the underground spread of fire along roots. Violations will result in a Civil Penalty of \$500.00+cost, with Zero Tolerance. By signing you are also authorizing TTPOA Security to check site for compliance of all regulations.
